

WHAT IS RACISM

Racism is when someone is treated differently or unfairly just because of his or her race or culture.

Racism can be-

- Written or verbal threats or insults
- Personal attacks of any kind, including violence
- Being treated differently or being excluded because of your race or culture
- Having people make assumptions about you because of your race or culture
- People making racist jokes.

It is illegal to treat people differently or unfairly because of their race. Nobody has the right to make you feel bad or abuse you.
