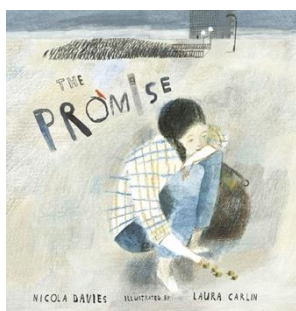
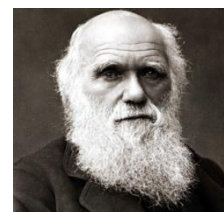

<p>We will be studying two key text this term: The Promise From these texts we will be writing: Sequels, diaries, reports and letters. We will focus on using our inference skills to deduce information from the text whilst studying Year 6 grammar objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recap of Year 4 grammar - Prefix and suffix rules - Indicating degrees of possibility using adverbs or modal verbs. - Devices to build cohesion within a paragraph. - Use of commas - Linking ideas across paragraphs using adverbials of time, place and number. - Using brackets, dashes or commas to indicate parenthesis. 	<p>We will be following the Power Maths scheme looking at: Fractions: Simplifying fractions Fractions on a number line Comparing and ordering fractions Adding and subtracting fractions Problem solving Multiplying and dividing fractions Geometry position and direction</p> <p>Times tables practise will be essential both in school and at home to help the children access the content in lessons with confidence.</p> <p>Interventions will take place to help support any gaps in the children's learning.</p>
