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How to help at home: Read lots of books and stories with your child. Encourage them to mark make or write their own names. Encourage your child to hold a pencil using the 'froggy finger' grip. Also, you could encourage your child to write some letter shapes with their finger or a pencil focusing on s, a, t, p, i, n and the letters in their name. Practice the rhyme of the week with your child.



In Expressive Art & Design and Understanding the World this term we will be:

Wednesday is **phonics** (I will put the letter sound on ClassDojo).


Thursday is **number day** (the children focusing on the numbers 1-5).



In Maths this term we will be:

- *Counting to 10+ in 1's
- *Counting backwards from 5-0 in 1's
- *Subitising (0-3)
- *Ordering by size
- *Recognising numbers to 5 and beyond
- *Writing numbers to 5 and beyond
- *Finding totals
- *ABAB patterns (caterpillars)
- *Data handling minibeasts.

How to help at home: Look for numbers in the environment (door numbers, car registration plates etc). Practice the number of the week with your child – touch count, write number labels and order numbers 1-5. Encourage your child to represent a number using the correct number of fingers.



In June we will be having some caterpillars from Insect Lore. The children will be able to study the life cycle of a butterfly and release them in to the EYFS garden. We are hoping to have the fire service visit us, this will enable the children to learn about the working world. If possible, we would like to do a virtual Watering Hole Visit. I think the children would really enjoy it and it would widen their understanding of the wider world and the animals that live in it.
