# Maths

This term we will build on the children's knowledge of Place Value and begin to work with numbers up to 100.

We will also be consolidating our knowledge of addition and subtraction and begin to add and subtract 2 digit numbers.

We will be continuing to count in 2s, 5s and 10s so that the children can begin to apply this knowledge to learning their Times Tables.

The children have all been sent home with Times Table Rockstars log ins and it is lovely to see so many children accessing it at home.



#### History

In History we will be learning about how London has grown and changed and about the Great Fire of London, its impact and how things changed afterwards. As part of the work we will be having a virtual visit to The National Archives.



#### Geography

We will be learning about the United Kingdom, as part of this we will learn about the countries, major cities, including capital cities and the sea and oceans surrounding the islands. We will also learn about the human and physical features of the UK.

#### RE

In Religious Education we will be learning about two religions this term: Christianity and Judaism. We will spend some time learning about festivals related to these religions.

### Design Technology

We will be designing, making and evaluating vehicles!

#### Art

In art, we will be developing our skills in painting and collage and our final piece will be a 3d scene of the Great Fire of London.

# Computing

This term we are finding out what Information Technology is, how it works and the impact it has on our lives and developing our photography skills using IPads.



# English

In Literacy, we will continue to focus on developing phonic knowledge, reading and writing.

We will be continuing to use The Write Stuff for our writing. This term we will be looking at a range of texts including: The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark where we will be writing a narrative, The Great Fire of London (Diary), The Bathroom Fiddler poem and finally How to make a Birdfeeder to develop our writing of instructions.



# Reading

We will be continuing to use The Monster Phonics books to support our reading. New books will be sent home each Friday so please make sure that reading folders are returned on this day so that their book can be changed.

### Spelling

The children will continue to have access to Spelling Shed and new spellings will be set each Monday, these spellings are the ones that are shown in their Monster Phonics spelling book.

# Science

In Science we will be focussing on Materials for the second part of the term.

We will be carrying out a number of investigations linked to the properties of materials. There will be an emphasis on teaching investigation skills.
