

Year 2 Newsletter - Spring Term 2023

Maths

This term we will build on the children's knowledge of money by exploring pounds and pence. We will be making quantities of money and finding change.

We will also be consolidating our knowledge of multiplication and division, working with numbers up to 100, focusing on the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times table and division facts.

Towards the end of the term we will be exploring measurement of length, width and depth, as well as temperatures.

We will be continuing to count in 2s, 5s and 10s so that the children can begin to apply this knowledge to learning their Times Tables.

The children have all been sent home with Times Table Rockstars log ins and it is lovely to see so many children accessing it at home.



History

In History we will be learning the lives of famous explorers, including Ibn Battuta, Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong. We will find out about their impact upon our understanding of the world.

Geography

We will be learning about where we are in the world in Geography, finding our locations to varying degrees of accuracy, and writing addresses. We will also be naming continents and oceans.

In art, we will be exploring the question, 'Can Buildings Speak?'. This links to our English book, The Building Boy, which is about an architect.

Computing

This term we are investigating how people make music using computers, and exploring the Google Chrome Music Lab.



English

In English, we will continue to focus on developing phonic knowledge, reading and writing.

We will be continuing to use The Write Stuff for our writing. This term we will be looking at a range of texts including The Building Boy and exploring non-fiction texts relating to Neil Armstrong and to Singapore.



Reading

We will be continuing to use The Monster Phonics books to support our reading. New books will be sent home each Friday so please make sure that reading folders are returned on this day so that their book can be changed.

Spelling

The children will continue to have access to Spelling Shed and new spellings will be set each Monday, these spellings are the ones that are shown in their Monster Phonics spelling book.



Science

In Science we will be focussing on Plants this half term.

We will be carrying out a number of investigations linked to the needs of plants and their impact upon the world. There will be an emphasis on teaching investigation skills.
