Maths

We will be following the Power Maths scheme that is followed throughout school. This term, we are focusing on addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.



Children will also participate in Memory Maths once a week, and will have the opportunities to learn and develop their understanding of the times tables.

<u>Science</u>

Our Science topic this term is Forces and Magnets. Children will be exploring different types of Forces through a variety of activities and investigations. Children will also study the different aspects of a magnet and find materials that are magnetic.

Geography

In Geography this term, we will be looking at Europe and the Mediterranean. We will be building up the children's understanding of Europe as a continent with a specific focus on the Mediterranean as an area.



English
