Maths

We will be following the Power Maths scheme that is followed throughout school. This term, we are focusing on Statistics and Measurement with a focus on perimeter.



Children will also participate in Memory Maths once a week, and will have the opportunities to learn and develop their understanding of the times tables.

Science

Our Science topic this term is Light. Children will be identifying different sources of light as well as understand how shadows work.



Geography

In Geography this term, we will be looking at Rivers. The children will look at the Water Cycle and understand how rivers are formed. We will also be going on a trip to Holmebrook Valley Park to do some work around rivers.



English



Writing

In English we will be using the Write Stuff, a concept the children should be familiar with already from last year. The children will be focusing on 'My Strong Mind' a book on Mental Toughness.

Grammar

Our grammar lessons take place once a week on a Thursday. The grammar lessons will focus on areas from our Write Stuff planning in order to help develop the children's understanding of these concepts.



WCR

In our WCR sessions, we will be looking at extracts from two books: Me and Mister P and Runaway Robot. We will be focusing on our decoding, retrieving and inference skills.

History



Through our History unit, children will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will be looking at where the Ancient Egyptians came in History and where in the world they settled. We will be looking at the impact they had on the world.
