

Year 1 Newsletter - Autumn 1 2023

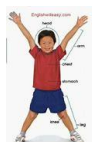

Maths

We will be following the White Rose Scheme of work and this term we will be focussing on Place Value.

We will be doing lots of practical activities to enable the children to have a good understanding of how our number system works. We will learn how to partition numbers, continue to work on counting, and learn how to represent numbers in different ways.

Science:



In Science we will be focussing on the Human part of Humans and other Animals.

We will be naming and labelling parts of our body and exploring our sense of taste, touch, smell, sight and hearing.

Art

Throughout the school we are going to focus on a theme each half term. This half term we are going to look at sculpture.
