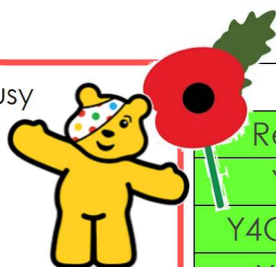




Our children have had a busy week with Anti-bullying activities, a Remembrance assembly, No Outsiders workshops and then today, children have taken part in Children in Need activities.
